Is your child interested in learning the basics of softball pitching? Does your child already pitch but is looking to sharpen her skills over the winter? Then the *Softball Pitching Clinic* is for you.

Designed to accommodate first time/beginner pitchers, as well as, those with experience across different pitching styles, your child will be able to work on their mechanics and gain more confidence in the circle.
